- 2. Written Treasurer's report Need to be uploaded earlier so all members can be prepared to discuss.
  - a. Proposed 2024-2025 Budget discussed. The goal is to transfer funds from other accounts that aren't being used to cover the Black KARE grant of \$2500 to be returned.
  - b. Link Cokie Diggs moved to transfer \$2500 from Restricted Commerce Acct to Restricted Fidelity acct to re- pay \$2500 Black KARE deficit, seconded by Link Sheila Kinnard, motion carried.


